WITH ART ANGEL

Art Angel's portrait charcoal program is done using a form of dry art medium known as charcoal which are often used by artists for their versatile properties, such as the rough texture that leaves marks less permanent than other Visual arts media. Charcoals are used to produce lines that are very light or intensely black, while being easily removable, yet vulnerable to leaving stains on paper.

Art Angel's silhouette painting is an artistic way to draw an image of a person, animal, scenery or an object rendered in a single colour. It is often painted against a light coloured background. The beauty of silhouette painting is in the shapes that emerge, as a stark contrast to its background, like shadows of what they represent. In this type of art form, the subject often stands out and simply looks astonishingly beautiful.

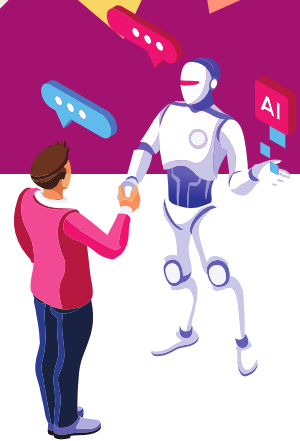

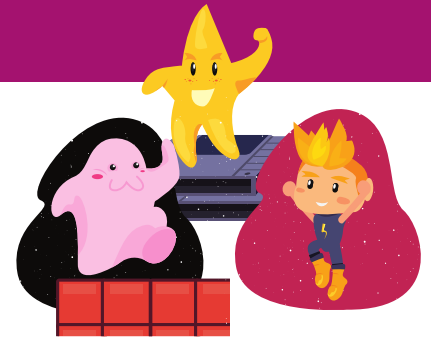
